

Six classes in the school undertook a water usage survey.

Of the classes surveyed we found...

98% turn off the tap while brushing their teeth

2% leave the tap running while brushing their teeth

89% take a shower

11% take a bath

50% take 5-10 mins in the shower

50% take 10-20 mins in the shower

11% brush their teeth 3 times a day

81% brush their teeth twice a day

8% brush their teeth once a day

46% use rainwater at home to water plants

33% use a hose connected to tap water

21% don't have plants to water

23% leave the tap running while washing dishes

68% fill the sink and wash the dishes

19% never use the sink. They only use the dishwasher.

When asked 'How do you try and save water at home?' the children responded with:

- Flush the small button on the toilet
- Turn off the tap when brushing teeth
- Take shorter showers
- Don't leave the tap running while washing dishes
- Don't fully fill the bath
- Only turn on the dishwasher when it is full

When asked 'How do you try and save water in school?' the children responded with:

- Only push the tap once when washing your hands
- Fill the basin or sink when washing up after art
- Use the small button to flush the toilet
