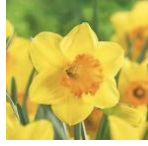

6th Class Problem

Daffodils are arranged into bunches of 12 flowers. A florist buys 9 crates, each with 150 flowers, from one supplier and 4 crates, each with 115 flowers from another.

How many bunches of 12 daffodils can be made?

4th Class Problem

There are 6 teams in a group. Each team plays every other team twice. How many games are there in total?

3rd Class Problem



Birthday Challenge

It is Jack's birthday. He asked his mother how old she is. She tells Jack she is 35. If we double Jack's age and add 5 we get the answer 35.

- How old is Jack?
- How old was Jack's mother when Jack was born?
- What number do you get if you add Jack's age to his mother's age?

2nd Class Problem



Ronald the Rhino takes 6 minutes to eat his dinner, 5 minutes to drink from the river and 3 minutes to walk back to his tree. When he was covered in mud, it took him twice as long. Covered in mud, how long did it take him altogether?

1st Class Problem



There were 54 bees in the hive. 15 of them flew away. Later, 8 bees flew back to the hive. How many bees were in the hive then?
